SMEIS wishes the Class of 2026 every success as they pursue their dreams and make a positive impact on the future.



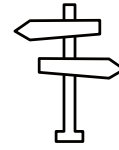

4. Making Good Choices Benefits

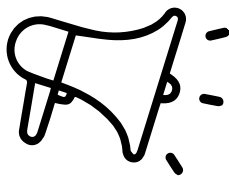
Others:
